

Powerline Contractors:

Pioneer Electric Cooperative is currently requesting bids from qualified contractors, for various reconstruction projects on our distribution system. We are electric distribution cooperative headquartered in Ulysses, KS; servicing 17,000 meters across southwest Kansas. In 2017, much of our system was damaged due to Winter Storm Ursa and like many, we've been working through the process of restoration and are seeking additional assistance. Request for proposal, bid documents and a sample Master Service Agreement are available on our website at <http://pioneerelectric.coop/resources/storm-restoration/>.

Work shall consist of the following and shall be to RUS specifications:

- Replacement of conductor
- Removing, installing and relocating poles and cross-arms
- Installation of additional poles and cross-arms on single and three-phase power lines
- General repairs on damaged power lines (replacement of cross arm pins and braces, replacement of pole-top pins, re-plumbing of poles, etc.)
- Refer to the request for proposal (RFP) for a complete list of work and requirements

Interested contractors will need to provide information pertaining to their company. Company information should include, as a minimum, the following:

- OSHA 300 log for the past 3 years.
- List of recent references.
- List of recent projects including the use of T2 conductor.
- Company profile including number of crews currently working and list of equipment.

All return bid sheets, bid bonds and requested company information must be submitted by 10:00 am (CST) on December 2, 2019. Unit prices must be submitted for every unit listed in the excel spread sheet (column C on install and remove tabs and column E on the WO tabs.) Bids will be accepted via email or hard copy.
